On July 1, 2021 Converse formally acknowledged its long-held university status with a name change to Converse University. Converse University encompasses the School of Business and Data Sciences, the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the School of the Arts, and the Graduate School. While Converse is now co-educational across all programs, through the programming of the Converse College for Women, we reaffirm the founder's conviction that a small, undergraduate, residential, liberal arts college is a uniquely powerful environment for developing women's talents.
